#### USDA RURAL HOUSING SERVICE Program Obligation Reports Through August FY 2018 Summary

The Housing Assistance Council (HAC) presents this month's report on Fiscal Year 2018 USDA Rural Housing program obligations.

As of the end of August, USDA obligated 120,246 loans, loan guarantees, and grants totaling about \$16.8 billion. This is about \$2.0 million less than obligation levels from the same time last year when there were 137,383 loans, loan guarantees, and grants obligated totaling about \$18.8 billion.

#### **Single Family Housing Program Highlights**

The Section 502 Guaranteed loan program, the largest of the Single Family Housing programs, obligated \$15.5 billion (107,018 loan guarantees) down from \$17.6 billion (122,910) at the same time last year.

For the Section 502 Direct program, there have been about \$945.6 billion (6,209 loans), up from \$911.7 billion (6,573 loans) in loan obligations this time last year. Very low-income (VLI) loan obligations as a percentage of the total Section 502 Direct loan dollars was 33.2 percent, down from 37.6 percent this time last year.

The Section 504 Repair and Rehabilitation programs obligated 2,771 loans representing \$17.0 million. Loan volume was down from this time last year (3,115 loans representing \$17.8 million.) There were also \$24.5 million (3,973 grants) obligated in the Section 504 grant program compared to \$27.8 million (4,577 grants) at the same time last year.

USDA's Section 523 Self Help Housing Grant program funded 31 grants and contracts totaling \$27.4 million which is up from last year at this time when funding totaled \$22.8 million.

USDA has also funded 14 credit sales representing \$1,591,104.

#### **Multi-Family Housing Programs.**

USDA's Section 538 Multifamily Housing obligated 118 loan guarantees totaling \$148.3 million, up from 80 loan guarantees (\$135.9 million.) In the Section 515 Rural Rental Housing program, there were 17 loans totaling \$20.8 million obligated compared to 20 loans totaling \$20.0 million this time last year. There were also 55 MPR loans and 2 grants totaling \$41.3 million and \$251,260 respectively, compared to 32 loans (\$21.8 million) and 2 grants (\$53,220) this time last year.

USDA obligated funds for 251,114 rental assistance units under the Section 521 Rental Assistance program totaling \$1.26 billion. This compares to about 246,269 units (\$1.1

billion) obligated same time last year. There were also 6,132 Rural Housing Vouchers totaling \$25.8 million compared to 5,342 vouchers representing \$21.0 billion this time last year.

In the Farm Labor Housing programs, 6 loans and 4 grants have been funded totaling \$8.5 million and 7.9 million respectively. Last year, there were 8 loans and 1 grant funded representing \$10.8 million and \$235,000.

There were also 6 Section 533 Housing Preservation grants totaling \$271,417.




