Approximately 76,125 Indiana veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 21.7 percent of Indiana veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2013, 8,727 VA home loan guarantees were made in Indiana to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 4.8 percent of Indiana's home mortgage originations in 2013.
