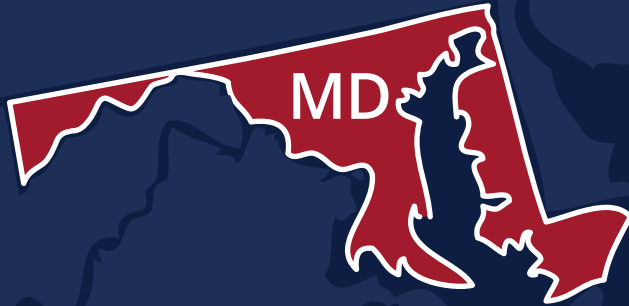

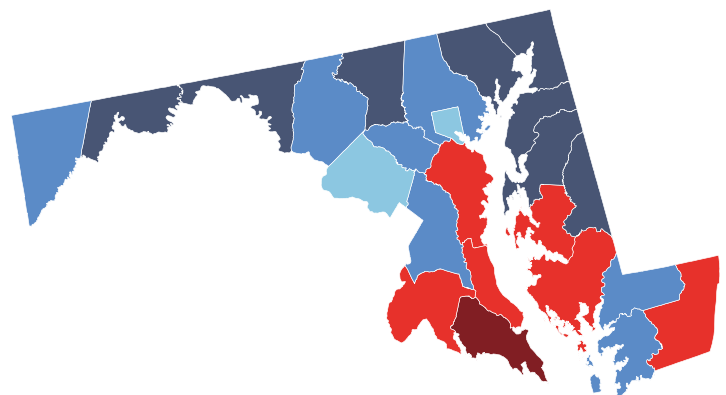

Approximately 87,014 Maryland veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 28.4 percent of Maryland veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2013, 15,633 VA home loan guarantees were made in Maryland to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 8.3 percent of Maryland's home mortgage originations in 2013.
