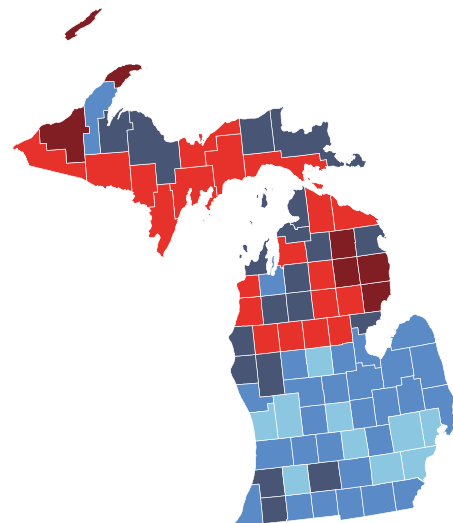

In 2013, 7,784 VA home loan guarantees were made in Michigan to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 2.8 percent of Michigan's home mortgage originations in 2013.
