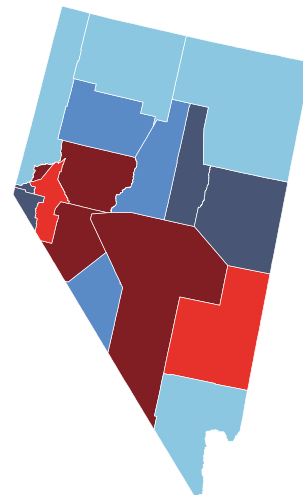

Approximately 56,120 Nevada veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 34.5 percent of Nevada veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2013, 7,939 VA home loan guarantees were made in Nevada to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.7 percent of Nevada's home mortgage originations in 2013.
