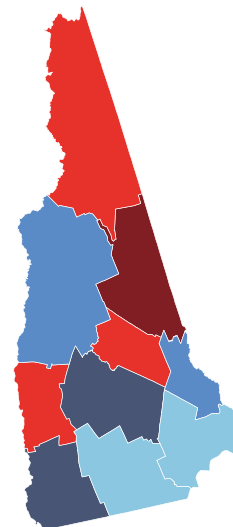

Approximately 25,612 New Hampshire veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 32.3 percent of New Hampshire veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2013, 2,069 VA home loan guarantees were made in New Hampshire to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 5.0 percent of New Hampshire's home mortgage originations in 2013.
