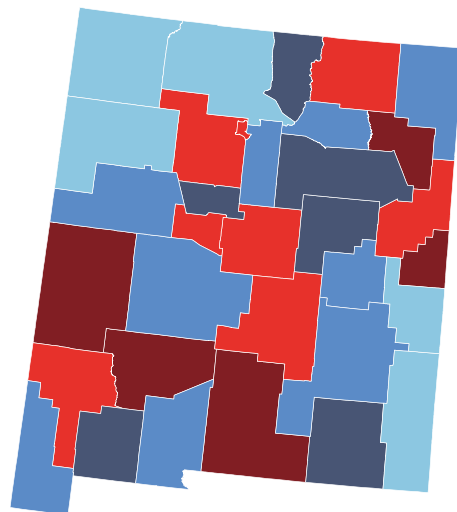

In 2013, 5,670 VA home loan guarantees were made in New Mexico to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 11.6 percent of New Mexico's home mortgage originations in 2013.
