

HOUSING PROBLEMS

205,522



Approximately 205,522 New York veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 30.3 percent of New York veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 7,254



In 2013, 7,254 VA home loan guarantees were made in New York to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 2.7 percent of New Yorks home mortgage originations in 2013.

HOME-LESSNESS 2,542



HUD estimates that approximately 2,542 New York veterans are homeless.
