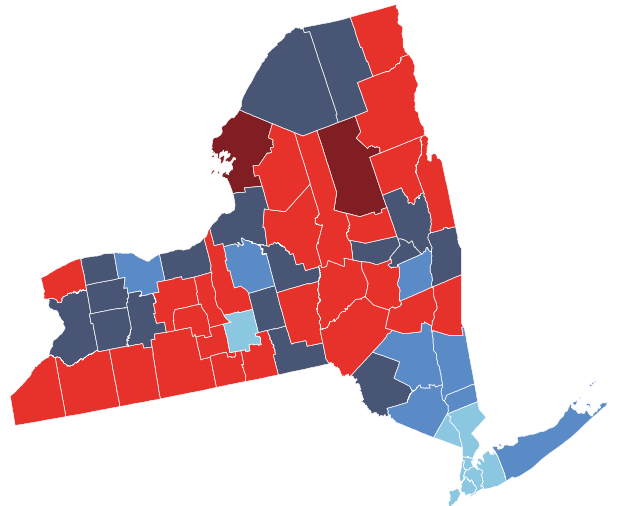

In 2013, 7,254 VA home loan guarantees were made in New York to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 2.7 percent of New York's home mortgage originations in 2013.
